EcoTip 2023 No: 69—Get Green-fingered

If you planted bulbs and seeds last year, you should be in for a bounty of
spring ingredients—rhubarb, new potatoes and spring greens are all ripe
for picking this month. But it's not too late to plant for summer. No
kitchen is too small to accommodate a few pots of fresh herbs
—sprinkle a few seeds of basil, coriander and parsley into little
pots of soil, pop a reusable food bag over the top to germinate
and expect the first leaves after about 5 weeks.
