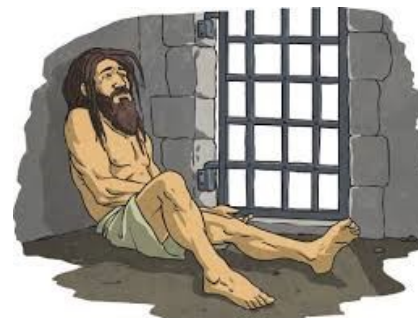

EcoTip 2024 No: 77—Buy a Metal Water Bottle

It takes 450 years for a plastic water bottle to breakdown into microscopic pieces. It will never fully biodegrade. They can't actually be recycled, only down-cycled. They are easily replaced with a metal bottle which you can keep and refill from the tap.
