EcoTip 2024 No: 83 Try Walking or Cycling to Church

We can all get into the habit of hopping into our cars even for quite short journeys like coming to church. Driving a car on short journeys has a very negative environmental impact. The engine doesn't warm up fully, resulting in higher fuel usage and more harmful emissions. On such journeys (less than 2 miles) cars can use up to 60% more fuel & pollute up to 60% more.
