
Lord of the harvest,



Today I awake and God is before me, at night, as I dreamt, he summoned the day for God never sleeps, but patterns the morning with slithers of gold or glory in grey.




Today I affirm the Spirit within me at worship and work, in struggle and rest. The Spirit inspires all life which is changing from fearing to faith, from broken to blessed.

I Timothy 6: 6-10



GOSPEL Matthew 6: 25-36
